In-text Citation. Basic Format: Last name, A. A. (Year). Title of article. Title of Journal, Volume number (issue number if available), pages. Example: Scruton, R. (1996). The eclipse of listening. The New Criterion, 15(3), 5-13. Note: The name of the author is reversed with the last name first followed by the initials.

APA Journal Citation / APA Format

Use this format to cite the retracted article itself, for example, to discuss the contents of the retracted article. First provide publication details of the original article. Then provide information about the retraction in parentheses, including its year, journal, volume, issue, and page number(s).

Journal Article References - APA Style

Paraphrasing citations: (Grady et al., 2019; Jerrentrup et al., 2018) Narrative citations: Grady et al. (2019) and Jerrentrup et al. (2018) If a journal article has a DOI, include the DOI in the reference. If the journal article does not have a DOI and is from an academic research database, end the reference after the page range (for an explanation of why, see the database information page).

Rules for Citing Journal Articles APA Style An in-text citation can be made in two ways: either by providing it in brackets at the end of a sentence (like in examples provided above) or by mentioning it in the sentence itself. In this latter case, author initials are dropped and the year is provided in brackets.

How to Cite a Journal Article in Print or Online in APA Format. Articles differ from book citations in that the publisher and publisher location are not included. For journal articles, these are replaced with the journal title, volume number, issue number and page number. The basic structure is: Journal Article Examples: Mitchell, J.A. (2017).

Journal Article - Citation Help for APA, 7th Edition ...

APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005). For direct quotations, include the page number as well, for example: (Field, 2005, p. 14). For sources such as websites and e-books that have no page numbers, use a paragraph

In-text Citation - APA Quick Citation Guide - Library ...

If an e-journal does not give something (e.g. issue number) it is omitted from the reference. Examples follow: Online-only open-access journal, volume number (no issue number) with "article number" (15) but no page numbers: Reference: Hoffmann, R., Lagerkvist, C. J., Gustavsson M. H. & Holst, B. S. (2018). An empirical examination of the conceptualization of companion animals.
