The fetal pig (*Sus scrofa*) belongs to the class "Mammalia", the same class to which man belongs. The gestation period of the pig is about 115 days and the fetal pigs are approximately 30 cm in length at the end of this period. Mammals are vertebrates having hair on their body and mammary glands to nourish their young.

On either side of the umbilical cord you may see mammary papillae, little nipples that will turn into teats in female pigs. 2.
