Indirect Questions Exercise 2 - Perfect English Grammar

In indirect questions, we don't use the auxiliary verbs do/does/did. Also, you can see that the verb is "open" in the direct question, and "opens" in the indirect question. Direct: Why did you move to Europe? Indirect: I was wondering why you moved to Europe. Again, there is no auxiliary verb did in the indirect question. In fact, this indirect question isn't even a question - it's more of a statement that invites the other person to give more information.
